

SERVE OPPORTUNITIES

On-Campus Ministries

Worship Ministry (individual or group training provided)

85 – 100 volunteers are needed to cover our four services each week

- **Acolyte** - serving as torch bearers, servers & crucifers
- **Chalice Bearer & Lay Eucharist Minister** - serving the bread and wine at communion
- **Usher** - offering assistance and direction in worship
- **Greeter** - welcoming guests, visitors and regular attenders
- **Altar Guild** - preparing the table and elements for communion

Children's Ministry

50 – 60 volunteers are needed for Sunday School each week

- **Sunday School Teacher** - preparing Bible lessons according to curriculum
- **Classroom Assistant** - assisting classroom teachers each week
- **Substitute** - filling in for teachers or assistants as needed
- **Sunday School "Lifeguard"** - being a companion to a child who needs special attention
- **Greeters & Check-in** - greeting in the lobby or helping with electronic check-in
- **Classroom Arts & Crafts** - helping prepare for class projects
- **Special Events Volunteer** - helping with Easter & Christmas celebrations
- **Vacation Bible School** - serving in a variety of over 100 open positions

Youth Ministry

30 volunteers are needed for Sunday School & 25 each week for youth groups & 15 small group leaders

- **Sunday School Teacher** - teaching prepared curriculum for Confirmation, Middle School or High School
- **Table Leaders** - working with a specific table of youth at any of the three levels above

- **Youth Group Parent Volunteer** - assisting with concessions & activities for Middle School Youth Group
- **Chaperones** - serving for camps, retreats or other activities
- **Small Group Leader** - leading weekly Youth Bible Study
- **Youth Activities & Events** - assisting with planning and decoration for special events
- **DiscipleNow Volunteers** - serving in various open positions from host homes to transportation
- **Office Assistance** - helping with administrative tasks in the Youth Ministry Office

Administration

- **Friday Collating Team** - collating, stuffing, etc of documents for church-wide use
- **Reception Desk Volunteer** - filling in for the church receptionist
- **Church-Wide Events** - assisting with conferences and large events
- **Fellowship Time Volunteer** - serving Sunday mornings in the Fellowship Hall

Operations

- **Audio Visual Technician** - running electronic equipment for special events & programs
- **Parking Lot Ministry** - serving as the first people our worship and special events guests encounter

Men's Ministry

- **On Point Men's Bible Study** - helping with hospitality, greeting and assisting in class preparation
- **On Point Co-Ed Bible Study** - set-up and hospitality
- **Special Events Assistance** - helping plan and execute men's conferences and events

Women's Ministry

- **Bible Study Table Leaders** - facilitating discussion and community at a table
- **Special Events Assistance** - helping plan and execute women's conferences and events
- **Office Assistance** - helping with administrative tasks in the Women's Ministry office

Small Groups Ministry

- **Small Group Leader/Host** - facilitating or hosting a small group
- **Small Group Counter** - talking with people about small groups after Sunday services
- **Special Events Assistance** - helping plan and execute small group events
- **Prayer Team** - praying for small groups and small group leaders

Life Care

- **Special Services Assistant** - assisting with families & guests at Baptisms, funerals and/or weddings
- **Office Assistance** - helping with administrative tasks in the Life Care office

Outreach Ministries

Seasonal Outreach Programs

- **Make a Difference Day** - leading or assist with community service projects in spring and fall
- **Kids in Need** - helping with school supplies summer project – sort, deliver, etc

- **Allen Community Outreach** - working in the ACO Food Pantry, Resale Shop, Meals on Wheels, or assisting with seasonal events and programs

- **Assistance Center of Collin County** - helping in the office, as a client specialist, or with seasonal programs
- **Collin County Committee on Aging** - Helping with Meals on Wheels (volunteers can be individuals, families or small groups)
- **Frisco Family Services** - assisting in their food pantry, Resale Shop, or with seasonal programs
- **Plain-O Helpers** - helping with minor home and yard work for other seniors or for individuals with special needs (volunteers are seniors)
