

## SESSION EIGHT

# Faithfulness

### Session Summary

According to John Wooden, one of the most important character traits that a person can have is faithfulness. To be faithful is to be a person who others “can bet the farm on and still be able to sleep at night.” The One who exemplifies faithfulness more than any other, the One upon whom we can count no matter what, is God. In this lesson, we discuss what it means to call God faithful, how we experience God’s faithfulness, and how we can become faithful people.

### Appointed Scripture

Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 1:15-22. Why is Paul’s faithfulness in question? How does he relate his faithfulness to God’s? Spend time specifically discussing verse 20. What biblical promises of God are fulfilled in Jesus Christ?

### Group Discussion Questions

1. What was one point from this week’s teaching that stood out to you?
2. Who stands out to you as a model of faithfulness? Who is one person you know you can always count on?
3. How faithful or reliable are you? Who counts on you?
4. What biblical stories can you think of that demonstrate God’s faithfulness to his people?
5. What promises of God do you rely on?
6. How have you experienced God’s faithfulness during times of difficulty or hardship?
